you?

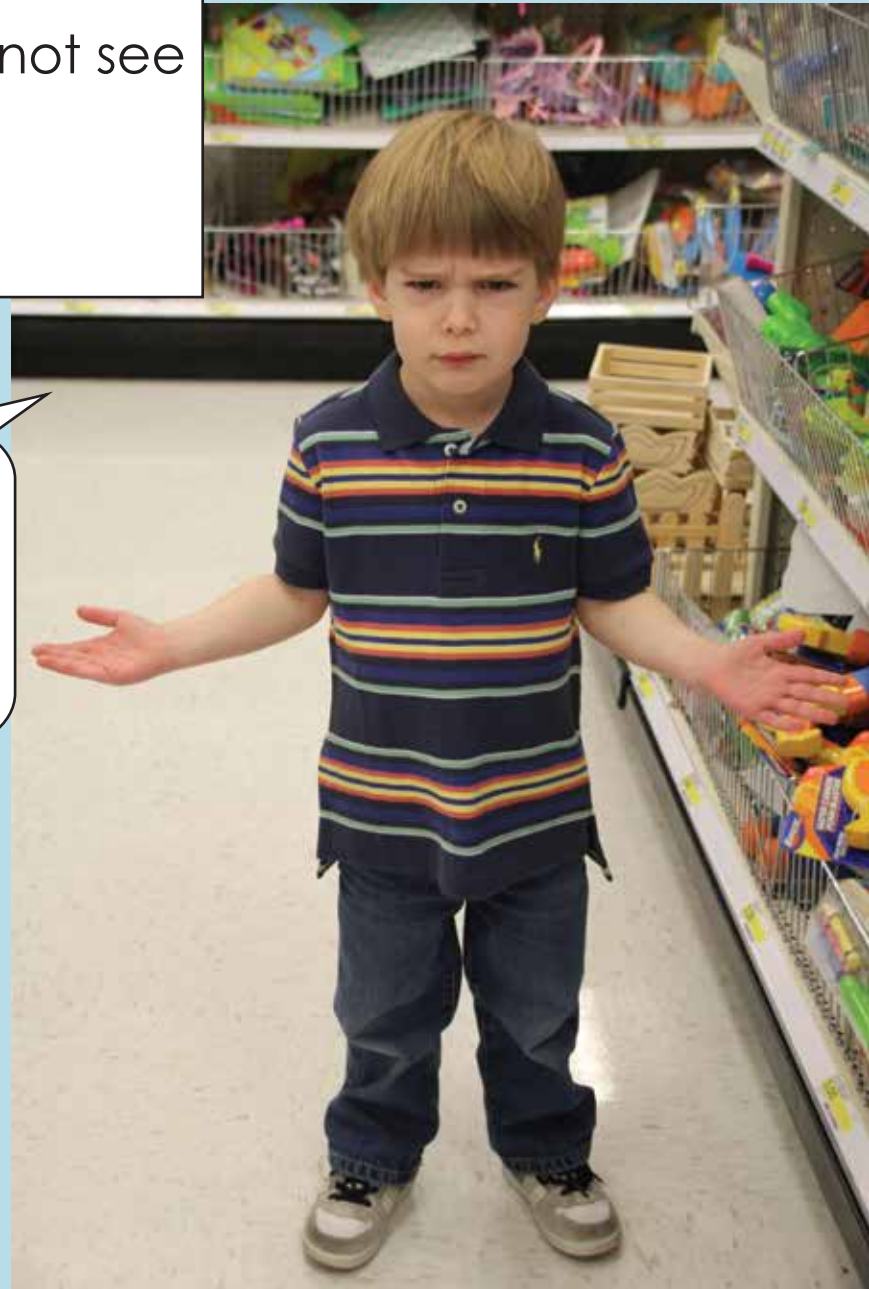


Rick looked around. He still did not see his mom. Look, he felt scared.
